John 3:28-30, TEV—²⁸I am not the Messiah, but have been sent ahead of Him. ²⁹The bridegroom is the one to whom the bride belongs; but the bridegroom's friend, who stands by and listens, is glad when he hears the bridegroom's voice. This is how my own happiness is made complete. ³⁰He must become more important while I must become less important."

Ephesians 5:25-32, TEV—²⁵Husbands, love your wives just as Christ loved the church and gave His life for it. ²⁶He did this to dedicate the church to God by His word, after making it clean by washing it in water, ²⁷in order to present the church to Himself in all its beauty—pure and faultless, without spot or wrinkle or any other imperfection... ³¹As the Scripture says, "For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and unite with his wife, and the two will become one." ³²There is a deep secret truth revealed in this scripture, which I understand as applying to Christ and the church.

John 14:1-6—¹Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. ²In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³And if I go and prepare a place for you, J will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. ⁴And where I go you know, and the way you know." ⁵Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?" ⁶Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

Revelation 21:1-5—¹Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. ²Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. ³And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God. ⁴And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away." ⁵Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful."
